NET OPENING

“All stations, this is W9WCA, Whisky 9 Whisky Charlie Alpha, your net control for the Wood County ARES/RACES Net.”

“This net meets each week at 7pm central time on w9mra repeater 146.79 mhz, with an access tone of 114.8hz.”

“The purposes of this net are to provide training, education, and information regarding ARES/RACES matters, and to encourage interest in and provide information about amateur radio emergency services in the Wood County area.”
